

In order to achieve our vision and increase the impact of our ministry, the LEGACY Campaign strengthens relationships, advances Christ-centered programs, and renews the facilities that sustain Northern Frontier for generations to come.

DIRECTOR'S LETTER

For generations, Northern Frontier Camp has stood as a testimony to God's faithfulness. What began in 1946 with a small group of faithful men who believed God could shape boys into godly leaders has grown into a thriving ministry that continues to impact hundreds of boys and young men each summer through life-changing experiences in God's creation.

Even before cabins were built on the land we now call home, God was at work in the hearts of men such as Joe Coughlin, the Frontiersmen, and the NY/NJ Brigade units. These men shared a passion for serving God and discipling boys and young men through the camp experience. Trusting in God's provision, they sought locations and built the necessary infrastructure to host summer camp programs.

Each year, God provided exactly what was needed in His perfect timing. Looking back today, we can clearly see how His guiding hand directed every step—from the camp's humble beginnings in 1946 to the establishment of a lasting ministry in 1964. Though the early volunteers could not have imagined the impact their work would have decades later, they trusted the One who held the future.

Over the next two years, volunteers generously gave their time, skills, and hearts to raise cabins, clear trails, and prepare the land for the camp's first summer in 1966. God's faithfulness was evident throughout this process, providing for every need at the right moment. In the years that followed, Northern Frontier continued to grow through the partnership of faithful supporters. Volunteers contributed labor, leadership, and resources, while campers and staff were shaped into leaders through outdoor adventures, discipleship, and relationships rooted in Scripture. God's provision was seen not only in finances and materials, but in the countless lives transformed for Christ each summer.

A major milestone came in 2013, when Northern Frontier secured permanent ownership of its Adirondack property. Through prayerful stewardship and the generosity of churches, alumni, and friends, the camp ensured its mission could continue for future generations.

As we reflect on nearly 80 years of ministry, we recognize that while our facilities are well-loved, they now require renewal after decades of faithful use. With confidence in God's continued provision, we move forward through our Legacy Campaign. This initiative celebrates God's faithfulness and invites you to partner with us in preserving and strengthening this ministry for future generations.

Because of your prayers, service, and generosity, Northern Frontier will continue shaping boys, young men, and fathers to love and serve God for years to come.



THE LODGE

Extending Camp's Mission

The Lodge is a planned investment in the relationships, programs, and facilities that sustain Northern Frontier's ministry. It will serve as a welcoming front door to camp—introducing people to Northern Frontier before they ever experience a summer session.

Building on our summer-focused mission, the Lodge is intended to strengthen what happens during the summer by creating space for connection, preparation, and shared vision throughout the rest of the year.

Once built, the Lodge will allow staff, alumni, families, and church partners to gather at Northern Frontier outside the summer months. Retreats, training weekends, and small-group gatherings will provide time to build relationships, deepen trust, and grow in shared purpose.

The Lodge will also support off-season leadership development and ministry partnerships, helping prepare staff and leaders before campers arrive. It will create space for planning, prayer, and growth so summer programs remain focused, intentional, and effective.

Designed to reflect the rustic character of camp, the Lodge will be built for durability, hospitality, and long-term stewardship. It will expand our ability to welcome people onto the property while protecting the rhythm and focus of the summer season.

The Lodge is envisioned as an extension of the heart of Northern Frontier. By inviting people into the life of camp throughout the year, it will help more boys and families experience the fullness of what Northern Frontier has to offer when summer comes. This is the next faithful step in stewarding the resources God has entrusted to this ministry.

COMPLETING THE WORK BEFORE US



Our goal is to fund these projects **by the end of 2027**. The journey has not been without challenges, but Northern Frontier has always been built by trusting God's timing and responding faithfully as He provides through those who believe in this ministry.

Many of our buildings and systems have served camp faithfully for decades, but they now need thoughtful renewal so this place remains safe, functional, and welcoming while preserving the rugged, wilderness character that defines Northern Frontier.

The garage will be relocated to the top of the hill near the site of the old stables.

This season is about more than maintenance. It is a moment of preparation for the next generation of boys who will step onto this property searching for space to renew their faith away from the noise of daily life.

These boys need time in God's Word alongside Christian brothers, freedom from constant technology, to grow in **character**, to develop practical **skills**, and to learn leadership through **service**. They need moments of stillness, wonder, and adventure in God's creation.

Completing and repurposing spaces that directly support discipleship, leadership development, and year-round ministry, such as The Lodge, program offices, gathering areas and craft spaces where hands-on learning and mentorship take place.

Strengthening the team needed to lead, maintain, and steward this ministry well so programs are delivered with care, consistency, and excellence.


WHY SUPPORT


The LEGACY Campaign represents a season of intentional renewal, ensuring Northern Frontier remains faithful and effective as the ministry moves forward.


